- attends meetings
- maintains membership by appointing new representatives as needed

1st Thursday: Monthly Team Meeting and by Meeting of the full membership of the Council. Executive Team Meeting (officers and Standing Team leadership)

3rd Thursday: Monthly Program Meeting open to the public.
